1. All classes will be judged under the Pony Club Show Jumping Rules 2019
2. Teams to consist of three or four Competitors
3. Rider and horse/pony combinations may not enter the same class in two teams or twice in the same team & neither may the pony/horse.
4. Teams will jump 2 rounds (even if eliminated in the first round) and riders in each, jump in succession in both rounds.
5. The total of the best three scores to count in each round. That total is carried forward to the second round. The highest score is discarded in each round and may or may not be the scores of the same competitor.
6. The second round will be timed and may be over a shortened, amended course.
7. Placings are decided on final faults and in the event of equality, the total lowest times of the best 3 rounds in those teams will decide the placing.
8. All competitors who go clear in 1st round become eligible for individual placings, adding their score to their second round score.
9. Individuals will jump once all the teams have jumped.
10. Individuals will jump second round in the same order as the first round.
11. Individual rider and horse/pony combination may not also compete in the team.
12. Save for death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers or anyone to whom they are in the lay responsible, neither the organisers of this event or the Soham and District Branch of the Pony Club or the owners of the venue or any other agent, employee or representative of these bodies accepts liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, cars, and their contents or accessories or any other person or property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or in any way whatsoever.
13. The organisers of the event have taken every reasonable precaution to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organisers and all the Officers and Stewards.
14. The judges' decision is final

Class 1: MINI TEAM/INDIVIDUAL

Teams of four and individuals
Ponies 13.2hh & under
Fences not to exceed **50cm** (approx. 1'7") in the first round

Class 2: MINI JUNIOR TEAM/INDIVIDUAL

Teams of four and Individuals
Ponies 14.2hh & under
Fences not to exceed **60cm** (approx. 1'11") in the first round

ARENA 2

Class 3: JUNIOR TEAM/INDIVIDUAL

Teams of four and Individuals
Rider and horse/pony combination not to have represented the
Pony Club at Area Novice level or above
Fences not to exceed **70cm** (approx. 2'4") in the first round

Class 4: JUNIOR NOVICE TEAM/INDIVIDUAL

Teams of four and Individuals
Rider and horse/pony combination not to have represented the
Pony Club at Area Novice level or above.
Fences not to exceed **80cm** (approx 2'7") in first round.

ARENA 3

Class 5: NOVICE TEAM/INDIVIDUAL

Teams of four and individuals
Riders and horse/pony combination not to have represented
their branch at Area Intermediate level or above
Fences not to exceed **90cm** (approx.2'11") in 1st round

Class 6: INTERMEDIATE TEAM/INDIVIDUAL

Teams of four and Individuals
Riders and horse/pony combination not to have represented
their Branch at Area Open Level
Fences not to exceed **100cm** (approx 3'3") in first round.

Class 7: OPEN TEAM/INDIVIDUAL

Teams of four and Individuals
Fences not to exceed **110cm** (approx 3'7") in first round.
